requested to:

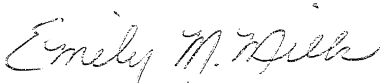
(1) Conduct a study into the feasibility of installing a traffic
light at the intersection of Old Spanish Trail and Slidell Avenue;

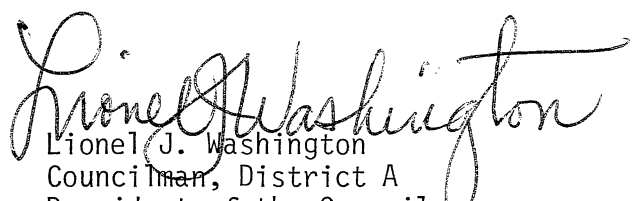
(2) Install a left turn signal (south) at the intersection of

(3) Install a left turn signal (east) at the intersection of Ninth
Street and Gause Boulevard.
