LEGISLATIVE COMMENTS AND REPORTS

Councilwoman Denham gave her time to Suzanne Krieger, Chairperson of the St. Tammany Levee, Drainage and Conservation District. Mrs. Krieger explained that there is a Constitutional Amendment on the November 13th ballot to approve an annual tax of five mills for the purpose of constructing and maintaining levees for flood protection. Mr. Barry Brupbacher from Neel-Schaffer appeared before the Council and explained CPRA (Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority) funding. Council Members Borchert, Pichon, King and Shives all asked questions relating to same.

Councilwoman Denham stated that the annual Fall Citywide cleanup will be held on November 6th at 9:00 a.m. in Heritage Park. She asked for volunteers to help work at Ducksworth Park on that day, as they are working with funds received from an MLK grant.

Councilwoman Denham congratulated KSB Director, Trey Brownfield, for receiving the Director of the Year award as well as the Circle of Excellence award from the Keep Louisiana Beautiful board during their recent annual conference.

Councilwoman Denham asked Director of Cultural and Public Affairs, Alex Carollo to talk about the upcoming Bayou Jam Concert. Mr. Carollo stated that the annual Bayou Jam Concert featuring Vince Vance will be this Saturday night in Heritage Park from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m.

ADMINISTRATIVE COMMENTS AND REPORTS

Chief of Staff John Welborn stated that the Olde Towne Zombie Crawl will be held this Friday night in Olde Towne and the annual Street Fair in Olde Towne will be held on Saturday and Sunday on and around the Erlanger area.

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POLICE CHIEF COMMENTS AND REPORTS

Chief Fandal stated that the Night Out Against Crime Community Event, which was held on Heritage Park on October 19th, was a home run. He stated that they plan to host Night Out Against Crime as a community event again next year.
