CONSOLIDATED PLAN

The Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program is an annually funded entitlement program from the Department of Housing and Urban Development. The Consolidated Plan is the framework to identify community needs, define priorities and focus funding to best utilize CDBG resources. The 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan started at the beginning of the City of Slidell's fiscal year on July 1, 2020. The five-year plan is in effect from July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2024 with specific annual action plans prepared each year.

ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

The Annual Action Plan is the City's yearly application to HUD, and it details how the City plans to spend the CDBG resources on specific activities. Priority is given to projects that carry out one of three national objectives:

- Benefit LMI persons.
- Aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight.
- Meet a need having particular urgency due to an immediate threat to the health and welfare of the community

The Annual Action Plan delineates projects, establish goals and creates performance assessment standards for each year the Consolidated Plan is in effect.

The Annual Action Plan

- Develops Annual Goals and Objectives
- Formulates projects
- Determines the Geographic Location of Projects
- Administers projects in compliance with City of Slidell and HUD regulations

2022-2023 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

The 2022-2023 Annual Action Plan represents the third year application submitted to HUD as part of the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan.

The City will provide funds for recreation improvements in Ducksworth Park.

- This fulfills the goal to provide public facility improvements in the CDBG target area CT 409. Activities will improve the quality of life of area residents by enhancing recreation opportunity.

The city will establish activities for Urgent Needs for both public facility and public services. The

activities are undefined and not yet funded. They will be determined as need arises in the event of a disaster or emergency.

- The goal for this activity is to be proactive in responding to a critical need that may result from a disaster or emergency.

The City will receive \$191,720 for the CBDG Program Year 2022-2023.

SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENTS

In compliance with the City of Slidell Citizen Participation Plan, citizens are afforded the opportunity to comment on substantial amendments to annual action plans which create a new activity, change the location of an activity or make budget changes greater than 10% of the annual allocation. Listed below are substantial amendments the City is proposing.

2015-2019 CONSOLIDATED PLAN: ANNUAL ACTION PLANS 2016-2019

The proposed substantial amendments to the 2016-2019 Annual Action Plans are as follows:

2016-2018 Annual Plans: Allocates unspent funds to recreation improvements in Ducksworth Park.

2019 allocates unspent funds to additional improvements in Ducksworth Park.

2020-2024 CONSOLIDATED PLAN: ANNUAL ACTION PLAN 2021

The proposed substantial amendment to the 2020-2024 Annual Action Plans is as follows:

2021-2022 Annual Plan: Changes location of park improvements from Possum Hollow Park to park improvements in Ducksworth Park.
