- For public safety issues, side-by-side vehicles and all-terrain vehicles will not be allowed.
- Space is limited to the first 100 golf carts to submit their registration forms. Late entries will not be accepted.
- Once the total number of parade participants has been finalized, you will be assigned a Parade Pass via email. This Parade Pass should be presented at the Parade Sign-in on July 4 but does not need to be displayed on the golf cart.
- Golf carts should be decorated in a patriotic theme or things that celebrate America (sports, pop culture, food, music, etc).
- Participants are encouraged to throw beads, plastic cups, individually wrapped candy, stuffed animals, plastic toys and other items, but do not throw anything with hard edges or sharp points.
- No lewd or profane costumes, decorations, music, language, or throws will be allowed.

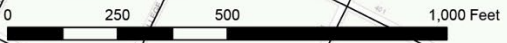
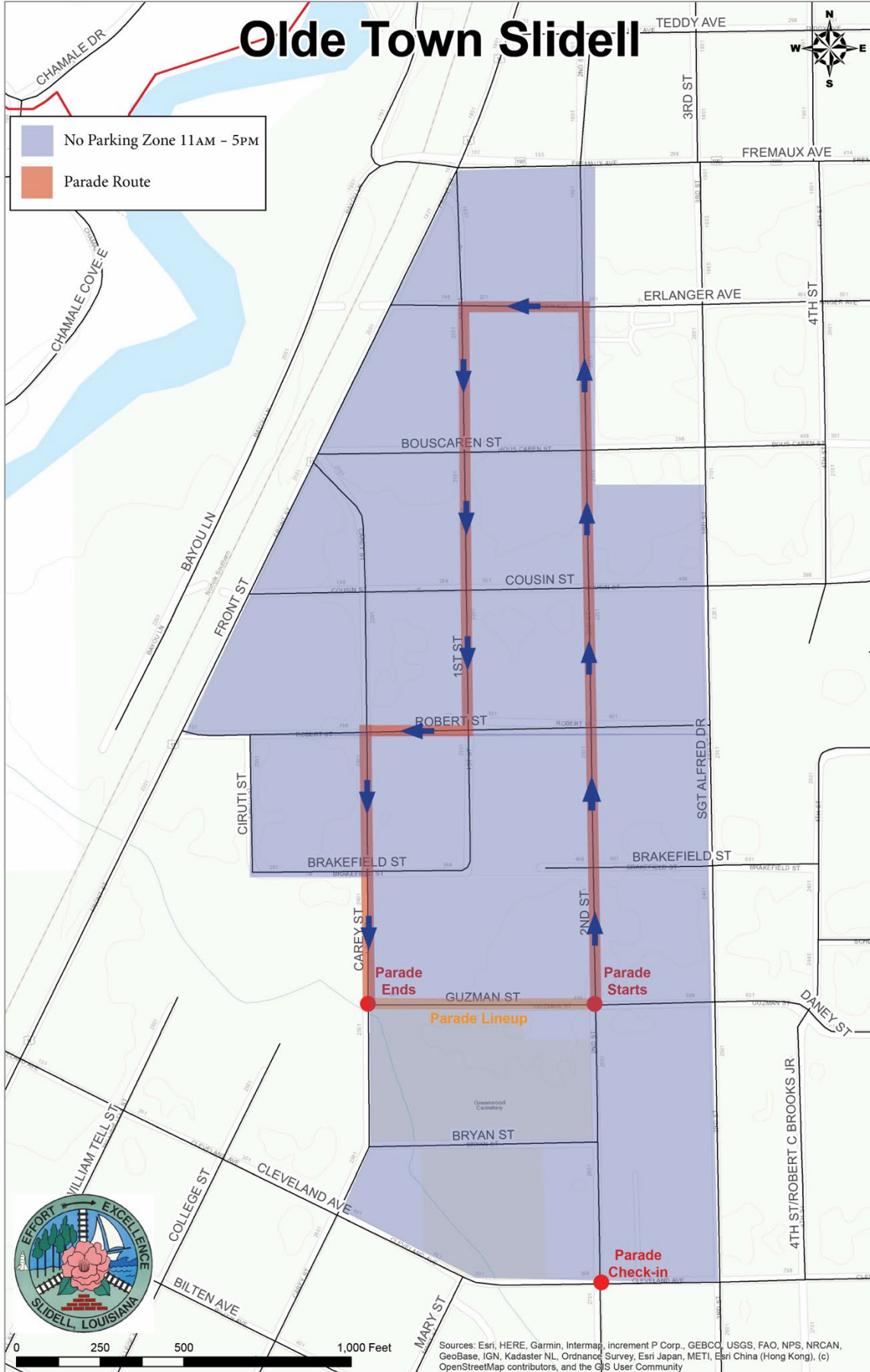
