AMENDMENT TO SECTION 6-2 AND 6-3, CHAPTER 6, BICYCLES

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell that Section 6-2 of the Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-2. Registration fee.

There shall be no charge for the seal or certificate of registration.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell that Section 6-3 of the Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

Section 6-3. Duration of registration.

The registration of a bicycle shall be effective for as long as the registered owner remains the owner of the bicycle. When a bicycle changes ownership, it shall be the responsibility of the new owner to register the bicycle with the police department and to secure a new seal or certificate of registration from the department, within sixty days of the transfer of ownership.
