ORDINANCE NO. 1347

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of thirty (.30) one hundredths mill on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the 1958 Sewerage Public Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1981.


SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of thirty (.30) one hundredths mill on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the City of Slidell according to the assessment roll of the said City for the year 1980.


SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds of the Sewerage Public Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1981, as duly authorized by a special taxpayers election held July 23, 1957 and by a Resolution of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 12th day of April, 1958.

ADOPTED this 13th day of January , 1981.


