ORDINANCE NO. 1379

An ordinance declaring the park commonly referred to as
Claude Street Park, the "Clifton C. Ducksworth Municipal
Park."

WHEREAS, Clifton C. Ducksworth was one of Slidell's greatest sons, and

WHEREAS, Clifton C. Ducksworth gave unselfishly of himself to this
community, especially its youth, and

WHEREAS, Clifton C. Ducksworth practically became a legend in his
own time,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal
session convened, that the City of Slidell pay a special honor and tribute to
one of its most respected citizens in officially naming the park commonly referred
to as Claude Street Park the "Clifton C. Ducksworth Municipal Park" in his honor.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a copy of this act be prominently displayed
in the park for the benefit of future generations.




