## ORDINANCE NO. 1436

An ordinance amending Sections 308, 314, and 315 of the 1979 Edition of the Standard Swimming Pool Code of the Southern Building Code Congress International, Inc., adopted by Ordinance No. 1414, July 14th, 1981.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that Sections 308, 314, and 315 of the 1979 Edition of the Standard Swimming Pool Code of the Southern Building Code Congress International, Inc., adopted by Ordinance No. 1414, July 14th, 1981, is amended as follows:

Section 308, Waste Water Disposal, add the following:

- (d) Filter backwash water and pool drain water shall be disposed of in the following manner:
  - To a subsurface drainage system by direct connection through the wall of a catch basin, or a tapped connection to the drainage pipe when approved by the City Engineer.
  - To an open drainage ditch in front, back or sides of the property, providing that no water will be allowed to flow into adjacent property, over sidewalks, driveways or other paved areas.
  - 3. To the gutter portion of a paved roadway where curbs are built but no subsurface drainage exists fronting the property.
  - 4. Connections to the sanitary sewer collection system will not be permitted. This restriction includes septic tanks, disposal fields, filtering beds and cesspools.
  - 5. Irrigation systems for lawns or gardens will be permitted to use backwash or drain water, but this means of water disposal will not be accepted as a substitution of 1, 2 or 3 aforedescribed.

Section 314 - Electrical

Reference to the National Electrical Code, latest edition, is specifically made in regard to Article 680 - "Swimming Pools, Fountains, and similar installations".

Section 315 - Final Inspection - Enclosure Required

Add: For the purpose of clarification, the terms "fence" or "substantial structure" shall mean any commercially available fence or

wall system which effectively prevents the passage of children and pets from the ground to a height of five (5) feet.
