ORDINANCE NO. 1437

An ordinance declaring certain property of the City of  
Slidell surplus and setting the method of disposing of  
same.

The Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, does hereby ordain  
that the following property is declared to be surplus and no longer needed for  
public uses.

Be it also ordained that the following vehicles shall be sold at or above  
the minimum price listed with each.

The above property shall be sold to the highest bidder who shall submit  
a sealed bid meeting specifications. Date, time and place of sale are to be  
fixed by the Mayor of Slidell, who shall also establish method of payment  
and other specifications for bidders, including deadline for removal.

A public hearing shall be held on this ordinance at which time opposition  
to the ordinance may be stated.
