ORDINANCE NO. 1443

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council did receive a petition from
Reverend James H. Norcross representing Slidell First Church of the
Nazarene, requesting the annexation and zoning from Parish to A-6 Single
Family Urban, and

WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission, in a letter
dated September 22, 1981, approved such annexation and zoning, and by
publication in the Daily Sentry News on October 18th, October 25th, and
November 1st, 1981, the Council gave notice of their intention to take action
on said petition by calling a public hearing on November 10, 1981, in the
Council Chambers,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in
legal session convened, that the following described property be annexed
into Councilmanic District E and zoned A-6.

ALL that certain parcel of land being situated in Section 11,
Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana,
being more fully described as follows:

From the Section corner common to Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12 in
said Township and Range, thence South 89 degrees, 52 minutes West
3175.92 feet to a point; thence South 2640.00 feet to the Southern
Right-of-Way line of Fremeaux Avenue; thence along said Right-of-
Way line North 89 degrees, 29 minutes, 55 seconds East 82.86 feet
to the point of beginning. Thence South 300.00 feet to a point;
thence South 89 degrees, 29 minutes, 55 seconds West 281.89 feet to
a point; thence North 300.00 feet to the Southern Right-of-Way line
of Fremeaux Avenue; thence along said Right-of-Way line North 89
degrees, 29 minutes, 55 seconds East 281.89 feet to the point of
beginning. Containing in all 1.94 acres of land, more or less.
