ORDINANCE NO. 1447

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened,
that to the extent permitted by law, and to the extent compatible with the City's
needs, preference shall be given to businesses actually located within the City
of Slidell (and/or whose owners pay ad valorem taxes to the City of Slidell) in
the purchase of all goods and/or services by the City of Slidell.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all advertisements for goods and/or services
to be purchased by the City of Slidell shall bear this notice:

All proposals, bids, and applications are welcomed. To the
extent permitted by law, and to the extent compatible with
the City's needs, preference shall be given to businesses actually
located within the City of Slidell and/or whose owners pay ad
valorem taxes to the City of Slidell.
