ORDINANCE NO. 1471

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of fifty (.50) one hundredths mills on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the 1974 Street Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell, for the year 1982.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of fifty (.50) one hundredths mills on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, according to the assessment roll of the said City for the year 1981.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special tax is levied for the prupose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing Bonds of the 1974 Street Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1982, as duly authorized by a special taxpayer election held on December 15, 1973, and by Resolution of the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 18th day of December 1973 and January 22, 1974.
