ORDINANCE NO. 1474

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of one and seventy one hundredths (1.70) mills on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the 1976 Drainage Improvement Bonds Series A of the City of Slidell, for the year 1982.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Slidell, Louisiana in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of one and seventy one hundredths (1.70) mills on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the City of Slidell, according to the assessment roll of the said City for the year 1981.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds of the 1976 Drainage Improvement Bonds for the City of Slidell for the year 1982, as duly authorized by a special taxpayers election held on April 13, 1976, and by Resolutions of the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 13th day of April, 1976, and the 25th day of May, 1976.
