ORDINANCE NO. 1476

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of two and forty one hundredths (2.40) mills on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the 1977 Sewerage Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1981.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of two and forty (2.40) one hundredths mills on the dollar on all taxable property under the Laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, according to the assessment roll of the said City of the year 1981.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds of the 1977 Sewerage Improvement Bonds, for the City of Slidell for the year 1982, as duly authorized by a special taxpayers election held on April 13, 1976; and by Resolutions passed by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 13th day of April, 1976, and the 16th day of November, 1976.
