ORDINANCE NO. 1491

An ordinance declaring certain property of the City of
Slidell surplus and setting the method of disposing of
same.

The Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, does hereby
ordain that the following property is declared to be surplus and no longer
needed for public uses.

Be it also ordained that the following scrap iron shall be sold
at or above the minimum price listed.

<u>Description</u>	<u>Minimum Price</u>
One Pile of Scrap Iron	\$1.00

The above property shall be sold to the highest bidder by sealed
bid. Date, time and place of sale are to be fixed by the Mayor of Slidell,
who shall also establish method of payment and other specifications for
bidders, including deadline for removal.


Because it is in the best interest of the city to clear this item
from city property, if no bid is received the Mayor of Slidell is hereby
authorized to negotiate with any interested party for sale at any rate.


A public hearing shall be held on this ordinance at which time
opposition to the ordinance may be stated.


