ORDINANCE NO. 1505

An ordinance declaring certain property of the City of  
Slidell surplus and setting the method of disposing of same.

The Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, does hereby ordain  
that the following property is declared to be surplus and no longer needed for  
public uses.

BE IT ALSO ORDAINED that the following vehicles shall be sold at or  
above the minimum price listed with each.
