An ordinance establishing Immovable Property Inventory.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council in legal session
convened, that:

The City Attorney shall obtain a certified true copy of each
deed to immovable property owned by the City of Slidell. The said deeds
shall be filed by the City Attorney, the Department of Planning and with
the Clerk of the Slidell City Council and the Clerk shall file said deeds
in the archives of the City Council.

Provided, however, that immovable property acquired by the City
of Slidell at tax sales shall be exempt from the provisions of this
ordinance.




