City Attorney and City Prosecutor.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council in legal session,  
convened that:

Prior to taking office the City Attorney and the City Prosecutor  
shall be confirmed by the Council after being appointed by the Mayor.

Prior to confirmation the appointees may be placed under oath  
and questioned by the Council.

The term of the City Attorney and the City Prosecutor shall expire  
when the term of the appointing authority expires, provided that the City  
Attorney and the City Prosecutor shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor.

ADOPTED this 9th day of November, 1982.


