ORDINANCE NO. 1602

An ordinance selling certain parcels of city property to the Slidell Bantam Baseball Association.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that:

WHEREAS, the governing authority hereby declares that the below described property is no longer needed for public purposes, and

WHEREAS, this property has remained vacant and undeveloped since its acquisition by the City of Slidell, and

WHEREAS, is it would be very expensive for the City to develop said property, and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell would benefit from additional recreational use by the sale of this property to the Slidell Bantam Baseball Association, the City of Slidell shall transfer the following property to-wit:

A. ALL THAT CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND being situated in the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 14, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana being more fully described as follows:

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 14, go North 00 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds 417.40 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence go North 89 degrees, 48 minutes, 00 seconds West 416.05 feet to a point; thence go North 00 degrees, 17 minutes, 44 seconds East 21.52 feet to a point;' thence go North 89 degrees, 46 minutes, 24 seconds West 208.54 feet to a point; thence go South 00 degrees, 06 minutes, 51 seconds West 184.14 feet to a point; thence go North 89 degrees, 48 minutes, 00 seconds West 69.05 feet to a point; thence go North 00 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds 419.86 feet to a point; thence go East 00 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds 693.90 feet to a point; thence go South 00 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds 259.79 feet to the Point of Beginning.

Commencing at the Southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 14, Township 9 South, Range 14 East go North 89 degrees, 48 minutes, 00 seconds West 834.80 feet to the Point of Beginning; thence go North 89 degrees, 48 minutes, 00 seconds West 485.20 feet to a point; thence go North 00 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds 208.70 feet to a point; thence go South 89 degrees, 48 minutes, 00 seconds East 485.20 feet to a point; thence go South 00 degrees, 00 minutes, 00 seconds 208.70 feet to the Point of Beginning.

Containing in all 2.325 acres of land, more or less. to the Slidell Bantam Baseball Association for the price and sum of Twenty-One Thousand and no/100 (\$21,000.00) dollars payable on the terms of no cash down and the balance payable in seven annual installments of Three Thousand and no/100

(\$3,000.00) dollars each, the first installment being due and payable on December 1st, 1983 and one installment being due an payable on the first day of December of each year thereafter until all are paid, with no interest, said installments to be payable in advance in whole or in part without penalty, and if the City Engineer files a certificate of need with the Clerk of the Slidell City Council, the said Slidell Bantam Baseball Association shall grant to the City of Slidell drainage and sewer line servitudes of the width and location of which shall be designated by the Slidell City Engineer.

This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after adoption.

The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign any and all papers or documents necessary for the completion of this transaction.
