ORDINANCE NO. 1617

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of twenty (.20) one hundredths mill on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the 1958 Sewerage Public Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1984.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, the governing authority of Sewerage District Number 1-A of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of twenty (.20) one hundredths mill on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the City of Slidell according to the assessment roll of the said City for 1983.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds of the Sewerage Public Improvement Bonds of Sewerage District Number 1-A of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1984, as duly authorized by a special taxpayers election held July 23, 1957, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 28th day of April, 1958.
