ORDINANCE NO. 1626

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of three and thirty hundredths (3.30) mills on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the 1982 Sewerage Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1984.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of three and thirty hundredths (3.30) mills on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, according to the assessment roll of the said City of the year 1983.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interes and maturing bonds of the 1982 Sewerage Improvement Bonds, for the City of Slidell, for the year 1984, as duly authorized by a special taxpayers election held on December 8, 1979, and by Resolutions passed by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 11th day of December, 1979 and the 26th day of January 1982.
