ORDINANCE NO. 1627

An Ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of three and fifty hundredths (3.50) mills on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the 1982 Drainage Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1984.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of three and fifty hundredths (3.50) mills on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, according to the assessment roll of the said City for the year 1983.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds of the 1982 Drainage Improvement Bonds for the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1984, as duly authorized by a special taxpayers election held on November 4, 1980, and by Resolutions of the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 11th day of November, 1980 and the 26th day of January, 1982.
