ORDINANCE NO. 1629

An ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, which shall set forth and designate the adjusted millage rate as required by Paragraph B, of Section 23 of Article VII of the Constitution of Louisiana and Act 433 of the 1981 Regular Session of the State Legislature for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal Police Department in said City in the year 1984.

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a tax of two and fifty-nine hundredths (2.59) mills on the dollar upon all property taxable under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in said City, according to the assessment roll of said City in the year 1983.

SECTION II. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said tax is levied for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1984. So authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, September 28, 1974, for 3.00 mills and revised as required by Louisiana Constitution, Article VII, Section 23 and Act 433 of 1981 Regular Session of the Legislature to two and eight hundredths (2.08) mills.
