ORDINANCE NO. 1637

An ordinance amending Chapter 3, Alcoholic Beverages, Article I. In General, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that Chapter 3, Alcoholic Beverages, Article I. In General, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell is amended by adding thereto a new Section 3-2 to read as follows:

Section 3-2. Sale of low and/or high content alcoholic beverages permitted at City Parks and other municipal facilities at city approved functions.

The sale of low and/or high content alcoholic beverages shall be permitted <u>in</u> city parks and other municipal facilities during the holding of special functions and with the specific approval of the city. City approval shall be accomplished in the following manner:

- a) The special function shall be placed on the Council agenda with proper background information.
- b) Approval for the sale of low and/or high content alcoholic beverages shall require a majority vote of the authorized membership of the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened.
- c) Upon City Council approval, the City's Finance Department shall issue a permit for the sale of low and/or high content alcoholic beverages at the authorized special function. The fee for this permit shall be ten dollars (\$10.00).
- d) The provisions of this ordinance shall go into effect on July 1, 1983.
