## ORDINANCE NO. 1640

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council did receive a petition from Mr. & Mrs. Michael Nodurft requesting the annexation and zoning from Parish to C-2 Neighborhood Commercial Zoning District, and

WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning & Zoning Commission, in a letter dated May 17, 1983, denied such annexation and zoning, and by a publication in the Slidell Daily Times on May 26th, May 30th, and June 6, 1983, the Council gave notice of their intention to take action on said petition by calling a public hearing on June 28, 1983, in the Council Chambers,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council in legal session convened, that the following described property be annexed into Councilmanic District G and zoned C-2:

ALL THAT CERTAIN LOT OR PARCEL OF GROUND, together with all the buildings and improvements thereon, and all the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated in the Southwest One-Quarter of the Southwest One-Quarter of Section 36, Township 8 South, Range 14 East, Eight Ward, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, which said parcel of ground is more fully described as follows: Commencing at the corner common to Sections 35 and 36, Township 8 South, Range 14 East, and Sections 1 and 2 Township 9 South, Range 14 East go in an easterly direction along the line common to Section 36 and 1 a distance of 216.6 feet to the point of beginning, thence in a northerly direction a distance of 143.5 feet to a point; thence at a right angle in a westerly direction a distance of 64 feet to a point; thence at right angles in a southerly direction a distance of 143.5 feet to the township line a distance of 64 feet to the point of beginning.
