ORDINANCE NO. 1660

An ordinance authorizing and empowering M.W. "Webb" Hart, Mayor of the City of Slidell, to lease on behalf of the City of Slidell, one parcel of land to the St. Tammany Fire Protection District #1.

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Fire Protection District No. 1 presently occupies the below described parcel of land owned by the City of Slidell, and;

WHEREAS, this Council feels that the lease of this parcel of land to St. Tammany Fire Protection District No. 1, will greatly benefit the fire protection district, the City of Slidell and its citizens,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that M.W. "Webb" Hart, Mayor of the City of Slidell, is authorized and empowered to lease to the St. Tammany Fire Protection District No. 1 for the price of one dollar (\$1.00) per year, for a ten year period and sign all necessary documents on behalf of the City of Slidell, the following described property, to wit:

ALL THAT CERTAIN LOT OR PARCEL OF LAND, together with all buildings and improvements thereon, and all rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, appurtenances and advantages thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, lying and being situated in St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, as follows, to wit:

Lots 11 and 12, Square 8, Robert Addition, Town of Slidell. Square 8 is bounded by Third Street, (Sgt. Alfred Drive), Bouscaren Street, Second Street and Erlanger Avenue.

Being the same property acquired by the City of Slidell by act dated October 27, 1950, and recorded in COB 197, folio 97, of the official records of St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana.

Said lease shall be renewable at the discretion of the Slidell City Council.

Such lease shall be come void if the land ceases to be used for a fire station such as it presently is.
