4 An ordinance to amend Chapter 9 of the Code of Ordinances of the  
5 City of Slidell, by adding thereto a new section, to be designated  
6 as Section 9-13 relative to the possession of alcoholic beverages  
7 of low and high content by persons under the age of eighteen in  
8 the City of Slidell.  
9

10 Section 9-13. Possession of alcoholic beverages of low and high content  
11 by persons under the age of eighteen prohibited.

12 a. It is unlawful for any person under the age of 17 to possess  
13 any alcoholic beverage either of high or low alcoholic content.  
14

15 b. It is unlawful for any person over the age of 17 and under the  
16 age of 18 to possess any alcoholic beverage either of high or low alcoholic  
17 content.  
18

19 c. If a police officer reasonably believes that a person is violating  
20 Section 9-13 (a-b) of this article, the officer shall take such person to the  
21 Slidell Police Department. The Slidell Police Department shall then contact  
22 the person's custodian and release said person to his custodian. If said person  
23 has no legal custodian, his case shall be referred to the proper court authorities  
24 for disposition. For a first (1st) violation of this ordinance by a minor under  
25 the age of seventeen a warning citation shall be issued by the Slidell Police  
26 Department. For any subsequent violations of this ordinance by a minor under the  
27 age of seventeen, subsection d shall apply.

29 d. Any minor under the age of seventeen violating the provisions of  
30 this ordinance shall be found to be "in need of supervision" as defined in LA  
31 C.J.P. Art. 13 and his case shall be referred to the proper court authorities  
32 for disposition.  
33

34 e. Any person over the age of seventeen and under the age of eighteen  
35 violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and  
36 be subject to a fine not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00).  
37

38 f. Severability Clause - If any provision of this ordinance or  
39 application thereto to any persons or circumstances is held invalid, the invalidity  
40 shall not affect other provisions or applications hereof which can be given effect  
41 without the invalid provisions of application and to this end the provisions  
42 of this ordinance are severable.




