## ORDINANCE NO. 1671

- A) Lots 14-25, Section III, BonFouca Estates and certain parcels in Section III bounded by Lots 14-21 on the East, Bayou BonFouca Road on the North, a certain body of water Bayou Lasseigne on the South and unnamed body of water on the West.
- B) Lots 22-60, Section III, Bayou BonFouca Estates.
- C) All of unnamed certain parcels of land, Section III, Bayou BonFouca Estates, bounded by Lookout Place on the East, Bayou Lasseigne on the South, Lot 18 on the West and BonFouca Road on the North.
