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33 B) Lots 22-60, Section III, Bayou BonFouca Estates.
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35 C) All of unnamed certain parcels of land, Section III, Bayou
36 BonFouca Estates, bounded by Lookout Place on the East,
37 Bayou Lasseigne on the South, Lot 18 on the West and BonFouca
38 Road on the North.
