ORDINANCE NO. 1674

An ordinance regulating the use of handicapped parking spaces on public facilities.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that it shall be unlawful for any person parked at a public facility, as defined in Title 40, Section 1732 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes, to park in spaces for the handicapped who do not have a license plate for the handicapped. Or a handicapped identification sticker issued by the Slidell Police Department. Whosoever violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).
