ORDINANCE NO. 1685

An ordinance declaring certain property of the City of  
Slidell surplus and setting the method of disposing of  
same.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened,  
that the following property is declared to be surplus and no longer needed  
for public uses.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the following property shall be sold  
at or above the minimum price listed.

DESCRIPTION	PRICE
Scrap Metal (pipe, mesh, fencing, vehicles, etc.)	\$50.00

The above property shall be sold to the highest bidder who shall  
submit a sealed bid meeting specifications. Date, time and place of sale  
are to be fixed by the Mayor of Slidell, who shall also establish method of  
payment and other specifications for bidders, including deadline for removal.
