5 An ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, which shall set

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of

21 Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied
22
23 a tax of two and fifty hundredths (2.50) mills on the dollar upon all
24
25 property taxable, under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in
26
27 said City, according to the assessment roll of said City in the year 1984.

31 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said tax is levied for
32
33 the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal Police Department
34
35 in the City of Slidell, Louisiana for the year 1985. So authorized by
36
37 the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana,

39 April 4, 1981, for 2.50 mills and revised as required by Louisiana Constitution,

41 Article VII, Section 23 and Act 433 of 1981 Regular Session of the Legislature

43 to two and one hundredths (2.01) mills.
