ORDINANCE NO. 1715

An ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, which shall set forth and designate the adjusted millage rate as required by Paragraph B, of Section 23 of Article VII of the Constitution of Louisiana and Act 433 of the 1981 Regular Session of the State Legislature for the purpose of the maintenance of the Sewerage System in said City of the year 1985.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a tax of four and thirty-three hundredths (4.33) mills on the dollar upon all property taxable, under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in said City, according to the assessment roll of said City in the year 1984.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay for maintenance of the sewerage system of the said City for the year 1985. So authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 3, 1976, for 5.00 mills and revised as required by Louisiana Constitution, Article VII, Section 23 and Act 433 of 1981 Regular Session of the Legislature to three and forty-eight hundredths (3.48) mills.
