WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council did receive a petition from Ignazio Sansone, requesting the annexation and zoning change from Parish Rural to C-4 Highway Commercial, and

WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning & Zoning Commission, in a letter dated August 22, 1984 approved such annexation and zoning, and by a publication in the Slidell Sentry News on September 2nd, 9th, and September 16, 1984, the Council gave notice of their intention to take action on said petition by calling a public hearing on September 25, 1984, in the Council Chambers.

NOW THERFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that the following described property be annexed into Councilmanic District E and zoned C-4:

All that certain parcel of land being designated as the East Half of an unnamed Street between Squares 2 and 3, Log Cabin Subdivision, Section 2, Township 9 South, Range 14 East, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, being more fully described as follows: From the Southwest Corner of Square 3, Log Cabin Subdivision, also being the Point of Beginning.

Thence along the Northerly Right-of-Line of Gause Boulevard (U.S. Highway No. 190) South 88 degrees, 53 minutes, 55 seconds West 20.00 feet to the center-line of an unnamed street; thence along said center-line North 00 degrees, 53 minutes, 37 seconds West 279.92 feet to a point, thence North 89 degrees, 05 minutes, 38 seconds East 20.00 feet to the Easterly Right of Way Line of said unnamed street; thence along said Easterly Right of Way Line South 00 degrees, 53 minutes, 37 seconds East 279.85 feet to the Point of Beginning. Containing in all 5.598 square feet of land, more or less.
