ORDINANCE NO. 1767


An Ordinance amending Article III, Municipal  
Employees Retirement System, of the Code of  
Ordinances of the City of Slidell by adding  
thereto a new Section 2-35. Ineligible full  
time employees.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal  
session convened, that Article III, Municipal Employees Retirement  
System, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell is amended  
by adding thereto a new Section 2-35 as follows:


Section 2.35. Ineligible Full Time Employees

Any full time city employee who is not eligible for  
membership in the Municipal Employees Retirement System  
shall be compensated in cash by the City of Slidell for  
that portion (percentage) of the employee contribution  
to said system that would be voluntarily paid by the  
employer (the City) to said system on behalf of eligible  
full time employees. For the purpose of compensation  
this section shall be retroactive to July 1, 1981.  
This section will apply only to persons employed by the  
City at the time of the passage of this ordinance.
