Eight and Nine and measure each seventy feet front on Lindebergh Drive same width in the rear, by a depth of six hundred and thirty feet more or less, between parallel lines, and located in the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 12, Township 9, South Range 14 East.
