ORDINANCE NO. 1778

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council did receive a petition from Elliot Reynard, requesting the zoning change from A-7 Multifamily Urban to C-2 Neighborhood Commercial Zoning District. This property is located on the north by 2442 Second Street, on the west by Second Street, on the south by Guzman Street and the east by Third Street.

WHEREAS, the Slidell Zoning Commission in a letter dated December 18, 1985 approved such a zoning change, and by a publication in the Slidell Sentry News of January 3, 8, and 15, 1985, the Council gave notice of their intention to take action on said petition by calling a public hearing on January 22, 1985 in the Council Chambers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that the following described property be zoned C-2 Neighborhood Commercial Zoning District:

A CERTAIN PIECE OR PORTION OF GROUND SITUATED IN THE ROBERT ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF SLIDELL and being Lots 7 and 8 of Square 29 therein, St. Tammany Parish, Louisiana, and more fully described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Guzman Street and Second Street, go Easterly along the Northern edge of Guzman Street 60.0 feet to a point on a concrete walk; thence at a right angle go Northerly and parallel to Second Street 120.0 feet to a fence post; thence at a right angle go Easterly and parallel to Guzman Street 90.0 feet to a fence post; thence at a right angle go Northerly and parallel to Second Street 60.0 feet to an iron stake; thence at a right angle go Westerly 150.0 feet to an iron stake located on the Eastern edge of Second Street; thence at a right angle go Southerly along the Eastern edge of Second Street 180.0 feet to a point on concrete and the point of beginning.
