## ORDINANCE NO. 1821

An ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, which shall set forth and designate the adjusted millage rate as required by Paragraph B, of Section 23 of Article VII of the Constitution of Louisiana and Act 433 of the 1981 Regular Session of the State Legislature for the purpose of paying and defraying expenses for general and local purpose in said City of the year 1986.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a tax of six and five hundreths (6.05) mills on the dollar upon all property taxable, under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in said City, according to the assessment roll of said City in the year 1985.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said tax is levied for the purpose of raising and providing sufficient revenue to pay and defray the expenses of the Municipal Government and for the general Municipal and Local purposes in the City of Slidell, Louisiana for the year 1986, as shown by the budget for the year 1986 adopted by the City Council of said City. Authorized by Louisiana Constitution Article VI, Section 27 at 7.00 mills and revised as required by Louisiana Constitution, Article VII, Section 23 and Act 433 of 1981 Regular Session of the Legislature to four and eighty-six hundredths (4.86) mills.
