## ORDINANCE NO. 1830

An ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, levying a special tax of twenty one hundredths (.20) mill on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the 1962 City Hall Improvement and Jail and Courthouse Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1986.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of twenty one hundredths (.20) mill on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in the City of Slidell, according to the assessment roll of the said City for the year 1985.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds for the City Hall Improvement and Jail and Courthouse Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1986, as duly authorized by a special taxpayers election held August 4, 1962, and by Resolution 662 of the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 6th day of August, 1962.
