## ORDINANCE NO. 1836

An ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana levying a special tax of one and fifty one hundredths (1.50) mill on the dollar on all taxable property in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, sufficient to pay maturing bonds and interest of the 1977 Sewerage Improvement Bonds of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, for the year 1986.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a special tax of one and fifty one hundredths (1.50) mill on the dollar on all taxable property under the laws of the State of Louisiana situated in the City of Slidell, according to the assessment roll of the said City for the year 1985.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the said special tax is levied for the purpose of providing an amount sufficient to pay interest and maturing bonds for the 1977 Sewerage Improvement Bonds, of the City of Slidell, Louisiana for the year 1986, as duly authorized by a special taxpayers election held April 13, 1976, and by a Resolution of the Mayor and the Councilmen of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, passed on the 13th day of April, 1976 and the 16th day of November, 1976.
