ORDINANCE NO. 1839

An ordinance amending Section 2-126. Exemption concerning water bill., of Chapter 2., Administration of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that Section 2-126. Exemption concerning water bill., of Chapter 2., Administration of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell is amended as follows:

Section 2-126.: Delete the present language in its entirety

replace with the following: No Slidell citizen sixty-five (65)

years of age or older shall pay more than three dollars (\$3.00)

per month for his water bill until meters are installed. Where

water meters are installed senior citizens shall be charged as

follows:

First 5,000 gallons.....\$1.00 per 1,000 gallons used

Each 1,000 gallons thereafter.....\$0.16

The provisions of Sections 2-121 through 2-125 shall be applicable

to this section.
