
30 2.2304 (a) (3): Delete this subsection in its entirety and
31 replace with the following language:

33 2.2304 (a) (3): In addition, any event sponsored by a public
34 veterans, charitable, educational, fraternal, civic or service
35 organization may locate banners across public rights-of-way one time
36 per year per organization. Such display shall be limited to two (2)
37 weeks per calendar year per event. Such banners shall be removed
38 within five (5) days (after) the event.

40 2.2304 (a) (4): Delete this subsection in its entirety and
41 replace with the following language:


43 2.2304 (a) (4): Community bargain days and trade fair week,
44 sponsored by the Greater Slidell Area Chamber of Commerce, shall be
45 exempt from subsections (a), (a)(1), (a)(2) and (a)(3) of subsection
46 2.2304 of this ordinance. Such display shall be limited to two (2)
47 weeks per calendar year per event. Banners displayed for these
48 events may be located across public rights-of-way.
