ORDINANCE NO. 1853

An ordinance amending Section 3-25. Location of business limited, exception, and Section 3-50. Location of business limited, exception, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that Section 3-25. Location of business limited, exception, and Section 3-50. Location of business limited, exception, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell are amended as follows:

Section 3-25. Location of business limited, exception.

Delete the first paragraph in its entirety and replace with the following paragraph:

All alcoholic beverage businesses excepting bona fide restaurants as defined in Section 3-18 (c), drug stores and supermarkets, are prohibited within three hundred (300) feet of a church, synagogue, library, playground or school. The measurement of this distance shall be from the nearest point of the property line of a church, synagogue, school, library or playground, to the nearest point of the property line of the premises to be licensed. Nothing herein shall affect the renewal of a license or the obtainment of a new license for a place of business that had a city permit to sell alcoholic beverages on the effective date of this article, provided that if the place of business within the prohibited three hundred (300) foot area is closed for any reason for more than one year, then it shall never again be allowed to reopen or be granted a permit.

Section 3-50. Location of business limited, exception.

Delete the first paragraph in its entirety and replace with the following paragraph:

All alcoholic beverage businesses excepting bona fide restaurants as defined in Section 3-18 (c), drug stores and supermarkets, are prohibited within three hundred (300) feet of a church, synagogue, library, playground or school. The measurement of this distance shall be from the nearest point of the property line of a church, synagogue, school, library or playground, to the nearest point of the property line of the premises to be licensed.
