20 BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session
21 convened, that Section 3-25. Location of business limited, exception,
22 and Section 3-50. Location of business limited, exception, of the Code
23 of Ordinances of the City of Slidell are amended as follows:

28 Section 3-25. Location of business limited, exception.

30 Delete the first paragraph in its entirety and replace with
31 the following paragraph:

34 All alcoholic beverage businesses excepting bona fide res-
35 taurants as defined in Section 3-18 (c), drug stores and super-
36 markets, are prohibited within three hundred (300) feet of a church,
37 synagogue, library, playground or school. The measurement of this
38 distance shall be from the nearest point of the property line of a
39 church, synagogue, school, library or playground, to the nearest
40 point of the property line of the premises to be licensed. Nothing
41 herein shall affect the renewal of a license or the obtainment of a
42 new license for a place of business that had a city permit to sell
43 alcoholic beverages on the effective date of this article, provided
44 that if the place of business within the prohibited three hundred
45 (300) foot area is closed for any reason for more than one year,
46 then it shall never again be allowed to reopen or be granted a
47 permit.
