BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that Chapter 7, Article 4, Flood Hazard Prevention, Section 7-31. Permit Procedures and Section 7-34. Specific standards for different types of construction. of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell is amended as follows:

Section 7-31. Permit Procedures:

Delete subsections (b) and (c) in their entirety and replace with a new subsection (b) as follows: (b) A certificate from a registered professional engineer or architect that the non-residential structure shall meet the criteria of section 7-34 (b).

Redesignate subsection "(d)" as subsection (c).

Section 7-34. Specific standards for different types of construction.

Subsection (a): After the words "substantial improvement" insert the words ,as defined,.

Delete subsection (b) as written and replace with a new subsection (b) as follows:

(b) Non-residential construction.

New construction or substantial improvement, as defined, of any commercial, industrial or other non-residential structure shall have the lowest floor, including basement, elevated to the level of the base flood elevation. A registered professional engineer of architect shall submit a certification to the administrator that the standards of this subsection, as defined in section 7-31 (b), are satisfied.
