28 required for each premises; exception. of the Code of Ordinances of the

30 City of Slidell is amended as follows:

32 Delete Section 20-2. and replace with the following:

36 Section 20-2. Separate connections required; exception.
37 Each premises other than a dwelling or residential unit shall be
38 separately connected to the waterworks system and each such premises
39 shall have a separate cut-off and water meter. Dwelling units or
40 residential premises shall also have a separate cut-off and water
41 meter except residential or dwelling units when two or more are owned
42 by the same person may be served by a single connection and water
43 meter where practicable. Where two or more dwelling or residential
44 units are served by a single meter or connection each dwelling or
45 residential unit shall be subject to the minimum bill each month
46 established by Sec. 20-7.1 of this chapter as well as the water
47 service charge at the established rate for all water used in excess
48 of 5,000 gallons per unit per month. The owner of each premises,
49 whether residential or non-residential, shall be responsible for the
50 charges for all water consumed in each premises.
