24 BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that Chapter 20.
25 Water., Article II. Emergency Water Control*, Section 20-20. Defi-
26 nitions., Section 20-22. Prohibited uses., and Section 20-26.
27 Finding of an emergency; termination thereof., of the Code of
28 Ordinances of the City of Slidell as follows:

31 Section 20-20. Definitions.

32
33 After the definition for "City" add the following definition:

34
35 Construction Emergency for purposes of this article will arise
36 when the City Engineer, Building Inspector and Fire Prevention Bureau
37 jointly certify to the Mayor that tests indicating inadequate water
38 flowthrough have been conducted in an area of the City or on a specific
39 building site and that contemplated construction in that area or on
40 the specific building site would endanger the safety of individuals.
41

43 Section 20-22. Prohibited uses.

44
45 Add the following language prior to the first sentence:

46
47 (1) Upon the declaration of an emergency,

48
49 Add the following language after subsection (e):

50
51 (2) Upon the declaration of a construction emergency, the following
52 acts are prohibited in the area or upon the site indicated in the
53 certification to the Mayor:

55 (a) Construction of any residential or commercial structure
56 that may be used by individuals;

57
58 (b) Additions to any residential or commercial structure that
59 may be used by individuals;

61 (c) Issuance of building permits for (2) (a) or (b).



14 Add subsections (c) and (d) as follows:

16 (c) The Mayor shall have the authority to declare that a
17
18 construction emergency exists, and the Mayor shall declare
19
20 that the provisions enumerated in this article as they
21
22 pertain to construction emergencies shall go into effect
23
24 when the Mayor receives the certifications required
25
26 under Sec. 20-20 and has given public notice of this
27
28 fact published at least once in the official journal.
29
30 (d) To end a construction emergency once it has been called,
31
32 the Mayor shall call an end to the construction emergency
33
34 conditions and the cessation of the provisions of this
35
36 Article upon receipt of a joint certification from the
37
38 City Engineer, Building Inspector and Fire Prevention
39
40 Bureau that tests have been conducted on the area or
41
42 building site in question showing adequate water flowthrough.
