WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council has received a petition from Charles I. Denechaud, III, Edward B. Denechaud, Barbara D. Boggs, Jean D. Kurth, and Deborah D. Slimp requesting annexation and zoning from Parish Rural to Planned Development a 1.259 acre parcel of property designated as a 60 ft. drainage servitude located north of Interstate 12 and east of the east bank of Bayou Liberty; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission denied such annexation and zoning,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Slidell City Council that the following described property be annexed into Councilmanic District D and is hereby zoned Planned Development with the following conditions:

- 1. The future use of said property shall be subject to the review and approval of the Slidell Planning Commission and the Slidell City Council. This ordinance does not grant or guarantee the future use or development of the subject property for any specific purpose.
- 2. All development plans must be reviewed and approved by the Slidell Planning Commission and the Slidell City Council in the manner described in Section 2.15 of the Slidell Zoning Ordinance.
- 3. No Planned Development plans for the herein described property shall become effective until final detailed development plans and specifications have been reviewed by the Slidell Planning Commission and approved by an ordinance of the Slidell City Council.

A Certain Piece of Portion of Ground, together with all buildings and improvements thereon, and all the rights, ways, privileges, servitudes, appurtenances and advantages thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, situated in the State of Louisiana, St. Tammany Parish, Greensburg District, Section 37, Township 8 South, Range 14 East, bounded by Interstate 12, Airport Road, Scenic Drive and Section 25 to the west.
