ORDINANCE NO. 2081

An ordinance of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, which shall set forth and designate the adjusted millage rate as required by Paragraph B, of Section 23, Article VII of the Constitution of Louisiana and Act 433 of the 1981 Regular Session of the State Legislature for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal Police Department in said City of the year 1988.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that there is hereby levied a tax of two and fifty hundredths (2.50) mills on the dollar upon all property taxable, under the laws of the State of Louisiana, situated in said City, according to the assessment roll of said City in the year 1987.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that said tax is levied for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the Municipal Police Department in the City of Slidell, Louisiana for the year 1988. So authorized by the special taxpayer election held in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, April 4, 1981, for two and fifty hundredths (2.50) mills.
