ORDINANCE NO. 2142

An ordinance authorizing an inter-governmental agreement by and between the City of Slidell and the St. Tammany 911 Communications District to provide a 911 emergency telephone service to the citizens within the Slidell City limits.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell Police Department has requested that it be authorized to provide emergency telephone service to citizens within the Slidell City limits; and

Caruso, or his authorized representative, is hereby authorized to execute an inter-governmental agreement by and between the City of Slidell and the 911 Communications District as attached hereto and made a part hereof.
